2. The Data Protection Officer's contact information

The Ministry of Finance has appointed a Data Protection Officer, who advises on the data protection rules within the Ministry of Finance. The purpose of the Data Protection Officer is to support the Ministry of Finance's compliance with the rules on the processing of personal data.

3. The purposes and legal basis for the processing of your personal data

We process your personal data with the following purposes:

- We process your information with the purpose of running the national eID-gateway. The purpose of the eID-gateway is to recognize electronic identification means for natural and legal persons covered by a notified electronic identification scheme in another member state.

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data follows:

4. Categories of personal data

We process the following categories of your personal data:

- Personal data
 - Name
 - Date of birth
 - Foreign ID
 - Birth place
 - Current address
 - Sex
- Personal identification number (CPR number)

5. Recipient or categories of recipients

We transmit or entrust your personal data to the following recipients:

- We entrust your personal data to the Agency for Digitisation's data processors, who assist with running and administering our IT-systems.
- The Agency for Digitisation transmit your personal data to the service provider, you should wish to use.

6. Where your personal data comes from

We receive your personal data from the member state's ID-provider, which is where the national ID you are using, comes from.

7. Personal data and storage

We store your personal data for up to 6 months. Within 6 months, your personal data is deleted automatically in connection with the deletion of the log.

8. Your rights

According to the General Data Protection Regulation, you have rights in relation to our processing of your personal data.

If you wish to exercise your rights, please contact us.

Right of access by the data subject

You have the right to gain insight into the data we process about you, as well as some additional information.

Right to rectification

You have the right to have incorrect information corrected.

Right to erasure

Under certain circumstances, you have the right to have your information erased before our general deadline for erasure comes into force.

Right to restriction of processing

Under certain circumstances, you have the right to have the processing of your personal data restricted. If you have the right to have the processing restricted, we will only process your information in the future – except for storage – with your consent or for the purposes of enforcing or defending legal claims, or for the protection of a person or an important public interest.

Right to object

Under certain circumstances, you have the right to object to our otherwise legal processing of your personal data.

Right to data portability

Under certain circumstances, you will have the right to receive your personal data in a structured, commonly-used and machine-readable format, and to have this personal data transferred from one data controller to another without hindrance.
